Covid 19 Update: Public Celebration of Mass to Resume at St. Peter's beginning Monday, March 15th, 2021

Beginning Monday, March 15th, 2021, parishes in the grey zone will be permitted to celebrate Mass publicly with 15% occupancy. For St. Peter's, this means a capacity of 115.

We will return to our normal Mass schedule of celebrating weekday Mass Monday to Friday at 8:00 a.m., Saturday at 5:00 p.m. and Sunday at 9:00 and 11:15 a.m.

Confessions will be celebrated in the side chapel Saturday from 3:45 to 4:30 p.m. As Fr. Michael is alone, he will need to stop hearing confessions at 4:30 p.m. to prepare for Mass.

Those who come to Mass ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A MASK. Please remain at home and watch Mass on television or our <u>Live Stream | St. Peter's Church (stpeterstoronto.ca)</u> if you have a fever, have been exposed to someone with COVID 19 or are sick.

Thanks to a generous grant that the parish received from the Family of Faith Campaign of the Archdiocese of Toronto, St. Peter's Parish has been able to install equipment for livestreaming.
